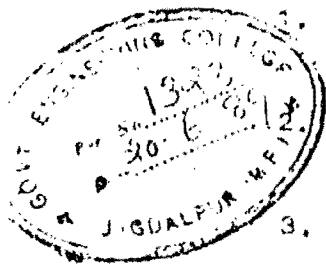
The total initial annual intake of 120 students as


